Dear Families,

Well we have a lot to get done during the month of November. In writing and reading we will be focusing on non-fiction text features. We will be constructing a poster with a heading, subheadings, captions and facts for our culminating activity. The topic will be animals and this ties in with our science lessons too.

In math we will be starting unit 3 which introduces standard measures of units using U. S. customary and metric units. We'll be working with area and the relationship between diameter and circumference. Students need to continue working on telling time and knowing what time it will be in 20mins./30mins. etc. Students also need to be determining how much money they will get back (counting change back) after spending part of a dollar or part of \$5:00.

In social studies students are learning map skills and locations.
